By car

Coming from the M50, go to Ross on Wye, then at the Ross (Wilton) roundabout turn right onto the A49 towards Hereford. After 5.5 miles turn left at Llandinabo onto the B4348 towards Hay on Wye. After approximately 2 miles turn left and go through and out of the village of Llanwarne until you reach a T junction with the A466. Turn right onto the A466 and continue for approximately 1.5 miles until you see the sign left for Pontrilas, Garway and Orcop (and brown sign for The Fountain pub). Turn left up here (Lyston Lane) and continue until you get to the village of Orcop Hill. Take the road which is the right turn *after* Birch View. If you pass the pub on your right you have gone too far! Continue along the lane for about a half mile. See **Access to Property** below for how to reach the space.

Coming from Hereford, take the A49 for just under 5 miles then turn left onto the A466 signposted for Monmouth and Wormelow. Go thorough the village of Wormelow and after about 1 mile turn right up Lyston Lane which is signposted for Pontrilas, Garway and Orcop (and has a brown sign for the Fountain Inn) and continue until you get to the village of Orcop Hill. Take the road which is the right turn *after* Birch View. If you pass the pub on your right you have gone too far! Continue along the lane for about a half mile. See **Access to Property** below for how to reach the space.

Coming from the South, i.e. Cardiff & Bristol, take the M4, A449 and A40 towards Monmouth then onto the A466 towards Hereford. After approximately 10 miles turn left up Lyston Lane which is signposted for

Pontrilas, Garway and Orcop (and has a brown sign for the Fountain Inn) and continue until you get to the village of Orcop Hill. Take the road which is the right turn *after* Birch View. If you pass the pub on your right you have gone too far! Continue along the lane for about a half mile. See **Access to Property** below for how to reach the space.

Access to Property

With a 4x4 vehicle, continue along the lane until you reach a yard on the right with a metal barn and small orange door. turn in here and go up the steep drive opposite to the top. Turn into the first section of the open outbuilding on the left. You have arrived! *It is very steep so make sure you are in the lowest gear. Please use this drive when you exit.

Without a 4x4 vehicle, continue along the lane for about half a mile then take the right turn at the signpost for R. A. Beaumont's M.O.T. Garage, up a private drive. Take the first possible left up a rough track. Go slowly as there are some drainage bumps on the track (unsuitable for low-lying cars, large trucks or motorhomes). Go all the way along here until you get to the owner's house and turn left through the red five-bar gate, which is before you pass the house. Drive in and park in the open outbuilding. You have arrived! There is a one way system in place so please exit down the drive beyond the outbuilding. This is a steep drive so do drive very slowly.

Parking is around 120 metres from the wagon.

By public transport

The nearest train station is in Hereford, 10 miles away

The nearest bus stop is a 5-minute walk from the house that goes to Hereford once or twice a day

When you arrive

To get to the Wagon, guests need to walk back up the drive onto the green lane via the gate they drove through, then turn left and walk behind the house and then bear left into the field along the top of the field where there is a mown path to the wagon. The Owners may also be available at the main house and are happy to walk you over if there.
